Home Appliance Recycling

Please purchase your recycling tickets at the post office.

- Home appliances that have been discarded due to replacements or not being needed anymore can be collected at the shops where they were purchased.
- They can be collected at the public office if the shops do not accept them. However, a recycling ticket must be purchased first.

☆Notes for purchasing a recycling ticket ※Please go to the post office after checking the items below.
 ・The name of the manufacturer and the type of the television set (tube or LCD/plasma display)
 ・The size of the television set, refrigerator, or freezer

※The discarded home appliance will not be collected if the name of the manufacturer or size is different from what is written on the recycling ticket.

☆Recycling and transportation fees are required. (Bank transfer fee charged separately)

Used Small Household Appliances

●There are collection boxes for small unwanted household appliances at 3 locations in the town.

Collection Box Locations

1st floor lobby at the town office, Fureai Koryukan Yu Hall, Machi-no-Eki Crosspier Kumiyama [Items to Be Collected]

Personal computers, mobile phones, telephones, radios, cameras, flashlights, DVD recorders, clocks, game consoles, etc.

※Items to be collected are small household appliances which can go through the slot (42 cm x 22 cm) of the collection box. Please consult the manufacturer of your personal computer if it cannot be thrown into the collection box through the slot.

Used Cooking Oil Collections

Collection date : Every 2nd Wednesday of the month
 Collection time : By 8:30 a.m. at the specified collection site
 Permanent collection site : Waste collection truck garage at the public office

Oils Which Are Collected

Vegetable oil, salad oil, tempura oil, soy bean oil, safflower oil, and olive oil which has been used for cooking tempura

Oils Which Are Not Collected

Fuel oil, lubricant, light oil, kerosene, edible animal oil such as lard, volatile oil

How to Dispose

Put used cooking oil with the leftover batter removed back into its original container and dispose of it in the exclusive collection box at the designated collection sites (public halls, etc.).

Effective Use of Resources

- Please have recyclable paper, old clothes, etc. collected by local collection groups or by waste paper recycling services.
- ※Group collection organizations can receive governmental funding.

Please dispose of household waste in bags designated by the town (colorless-transparent or semi-transparent, white garbage bags whose contents can be seen through).

Items Not to Be Collected

Dirt, gardening soil, concrete blocks, tires, automotive batteries, fire extinguishers, gasoline, paint, paint thinner, waste oil, kerosene, chemicals (agricultural chemicals), gas cylinders, motorcycles, safes, syringes, etc.

★Large-sized Waste (Paid Service) ★Reservations Required

- Reservations can be made by phone. (Collection day is Thursday)
- Please take it to a location where the collection truck can access it, and be present when it arrives.

Large-sized furniture, desks, beds, mattresses, tatami mats, etc., and waste that is temporarily generated in large quantities when moving are collected. However, the maximum volume that can be collected from 1 family per day is enough to load onto a 2-ton dump truck.

Office Waste is Not Collected

Waste generated by business facilities (companies, shops, restaurants, factories, etc.) is required to be properly managed by its respective business.

Please dispose of waste in accordance with the rules to keep the environment and the community clean and beautiful.
