



# Kumiyama Town Trash Rules

It is important to **reduce, separate, and recycle** trash.

★There are rules for disposing of trash. Be sure to follow them.

★Following the rules keeps the town clean.

## ① In Kumiyama Town, trash is disposed of in transparent bags.

★Always dispose of your trash in transparent or white, semi-transparent bags.

★Do not dispose of trash in bags of other colors, such as black or blue.

★Do not dispose of trash in other containers, such as cardboard boxes.




## ② Dispose of trash at the designated trash station. (Do not dispose of business-related trash!)

★A trash station is a trash collection point.

★Only trash listed on the sign at the trash station can be disposed of there.

★Ask a neighbor, or the owner or manager of your residence, where the trash station is.

★Place your trash in the net when disposing of it.


## ③ Trash collection days

★There are set days for disposing of each type of trash.

★Trash collection days are listed on signs at trash stations.

★Always dispose of your trash on the designated collection day.

★Do not dispose of different types of trash together.



## ④ Trash disposal time

★Please dispose of your trash by 8:30 a.m. on the day of the week designated by Kumiyama Town.

# How to Separate and Dispose of Household Trash (Kumiyama Town) Put trash in transparent or white, semi-transparent bags and dispose of it by 8:30 a.m.!

## Burnable trash [every / ]

**Food scraps**  
Drain liquids.

**Leaves**

**Paper / Cigarette butts**

**Diapers**  
Remove human waste.

**Branches**  
Cut to about 50cm, make bundles about 30cm in diameter and tie with string.

**Plastic containers that cannot be cleaned**

**Fluorescent bulbs**

**Spray cans**

**Lighters**

**Mercury products**

**Batteries**

Dispose of these items on burnable trash day in a separate bag.

## Unburnable trash [every ]

**Tableware**

**Bags / Shoes**

**Rubber products**

**Futons / Blankets**  
Roll and tie with string.(up to 2 items)

**Heaters / Stoves**  
Remove kerosene and batteries.

**Small home appliances that do not fit in the collection box**

**Dangerous items**  
Wrap in thick paper, etc., and write "キケン (Danger) on it."

**Broken fluorescent bulbs**

**Plastic products**  
Items 50 cm or longer (items that do not fit in a 45 L bag)

**Bicycles**  
Indicate "ごみ(Trash)" on bicycles. Remove batteries.

## Plastic resources [every ]

**CD/DVD**

**File folders**

**Wash basins**

**Toy blocks**

**Measuring cups**

**Insect cages**

**Buckets**

**Containers and packaging with this symbol**

**Refill packages**

**Plastic containers**

**Lunch containers**

**Styrofoam trays**

**Sponges**

**Bath chairs**

**Straws**

**Rulers**

**Bowls**

**Toothbrushes**

**PET bottle caps, labels**

**Plastic bags**

**Egg cartons**

Clean items with plastic interiors and exteriors, less than 50 cm long (no items that work with electricity/batteries)

## PET bottles/Paper cartons [every 1st and 3rd Wednesday]

- Remove labels and caps.
- Remove contents and rinse.
- Put only PET bottles in the bag.

**PET**

- Cut open.
- Rinse.
- Bundle with string.

## Cans / Glass bottles [every 2nd and 4th Wednesday]

- Applies to empty food and drink cans.
- Remove contents and rinse.
- Put only cans in the bag.

- Applies to empty glass bottles that contained food and drink.
- Remove contents and rinse.
- Put only glass bottles in the bag.

## Oversized trash [for a fee / every Thursday by reservation]

**Large quantities of trash**  
Temporary trash, such as when moving

Workers will collect trash at your home, but they cannot enter your home to remove trash.

- Applies to unburnable trash that cannot be collected, such as furniture.
- Reserve a date and time for collection with the town in advance, then dispose of the trash outside your home.
- Pay in cash after trash collection.

## Home appliance for recycling [3 methods of disposal for a fee]

**Air conditioners**

**TVs**

**Refrigerators**

**Freezers**

**Washing machines**

**Clothes dryers**

A: Request pickup from a store (recycling fee + transport fee)  
B: Bring to a designated collection location yourself (recycling fee)  
C: Request pickup from the town (recycling fee + transport fee)

These items cannot be disposed of at a trash station!

## Small home appliances (small items that work with electricity/batteries)

**Small rechargeable batteries** (batteries that can be repeatedly recharged)

**Small rechargeable batteries**  
Always remove these batteries, as they cause fires.

- Yu Hall
- Cross Peer Kumiyama

There are collection boxes at these 3 locations. Please bring these items and place them in the boxes. (Please cooperate in recycling.)

## Recyclable paper such as newspapers, flyers, magazines, books, and cardboard boxes

**Dispose of them with your local group collection!**  
Ask a neighbor, or the owner or manager of your apartment building, how these items are collected. It is important to reduce paper trash to reduce overall trash.

## Items that cannot be collected (Personally request disposal from a store or specialized business.)

**Motorbikes**

**Tires**

**Storage batteries**

**Fire extinguishers**

**Medical devices**

**Kerosene**

**Soil**

**Stone / Rocks**

**Bricks**

**Paint**

**LP gas cylinders**

These items cannot be disposed of at a trash station!
